What is laminate flooring?

Laminate flooring is cost effective, long-lasting, durable and easy maintenance. The structure contains 4 different layers as shown in the picture.

- High resistance overlay: this top transparent layer provides protection against wear, moisture, impact, stains and scratches with AC4 or AC5 surface commercial rating depending on individual product.
- 2. Decorative paper: this surface comes with a high definition wooden design; it is reproduced with sophisticated printing techniques, and usually finished with melamine resin.
- 3. High density fiberboard or Gencore: HDF (high density fiberboard) consists of refined wood fibers and high quality melamine resin. The floorboards are re-composed wood fiber extracted from chips and pulped wood waste. The unique technique brings laminate floor the special character of durability and stability. Gen-core is the pure optimal HDF core, and compared with HDF core, it's even more durable, stable and extremely moisture-resistant with FSC certificated.
- 4. High value back paper: avoids cup or bow when floorboard is properly installed and maintained, guarantees the outstanding balance of the board, and more importantly, it's moisture resistant from sub-layer.
